#### **Safeguarding Procedures**

To ensure that safety of all our children at school we would like to remind you about the importance we place on Safeguarding.

- •If your child needs to use the toilet before their session starts please use the visitors toilet we ask that parents do not enter the children's toilets.
- Please do not use your mobile phone whilst in the nursery classrooms or gardens.
- •If you are not going to be the person collecting your child from school, please let us know in advance we will not allow any child to leave with an adult we do not know.
- •If you are running late to collect your child for any reason please ring the school office to let us know.
- •If you see or hear anything whilst you are in nursery that concerns you please ask to speak to Julie or Suzie.

#### Sun Hats and Sun Screen
