

What we are learning over the next week...Exploring The Gruffalo Story



Reading

• Reading The Gruffalo story by Julia Donaldson and talking about the woods and creatures we find there. (Curricular Intention 4: To lay the foundations to become confident reader.).

Exploring

• Exploring natural items found in the woods - conkers, leaves, tree bark, sticks and so on. (2. To lay the foundations to become a confident communicator)

Counting

• Looking at the features of the footprints of the characters, counting how many toes they have and we have and looking at size (Curricular Intention 8: To develop number sense)

Singing

• Focusing on our Autumn song - All the leaves are falling down and 10 little conkers (Curricular Intention 10: To develop skills and processes for self-expression, creating with a purpose in mind).

Talking

• Talking about the senses and relating to the woods - what would we see? What would we hear? What would smell? What would items feel like?. (Curricular Intention 2: To lay the foundations to become a confident communicator.)
